AAA Heidelberg Passes Security Clearance

October 20, 2015 - Vancouver, British Columbia – **Chlormet Technologies Inc.** (“Chlormet” or the “Company”) (CSE: PUF) (Frankfurt: HR2P) (OTCPK: CHLMF) is pleased to announce that its subsidiary, AAA Heidelberg, has been notified by Health Canada that it has successfully progressed through the Security Clearance stage and has entered the Review stage.

This is a significant development for AAA Heidelberg and its application for a MMPR (Marijuana for Medical Purposes Regulations) license.

“AAA Heidelberg is now in a minority of applicants who have successfully moved through the security clearance stage,” stated Yari Nieken, President of Chlormet, “we are excited by the prospect of AAA Heidelberg receiving our license in due course”.

While in the Review Stage AAA Heidelberg’s physical security plans will be reviewed to validate the information in its application.

Since entering the preliminary screening stage, the facility has been built-out to meet the highest level of pharmaceutical standards. It currently features a state of the art HVAC and Surna Water Chilled Climate Control system. These systems provide the backbone of the facilities automated systems for temperature, light, humidity, carbon dioxide, and special ventilation for bacteria control. Grow lights, tracking software and auxiliary hardware have also been installed.

About Chlormet Technologies

Chlormet Technologies Inc. is also moving into the Medical Marijuana sector by purchasing a 100% interest in AAA Heidelberg, a private Ontario company that is in the process of applying for a MMPR license. Although the Company cannot guarantee nor estimate the timing for the issuance of a license to AAA Heidelberg, it is Chlormet’s goal to become the next publicly traded Canadian company to be granted a new medical marijuana production license.

VapeTronix, a wholly owned subsidiary of the Company is in the process of expanding its 1313 brand of electronic cigarettes and associated technologies.

With the purchase of the property in Whatcom County, WA, the company plans on generating revenues via long term leases to tenants.
